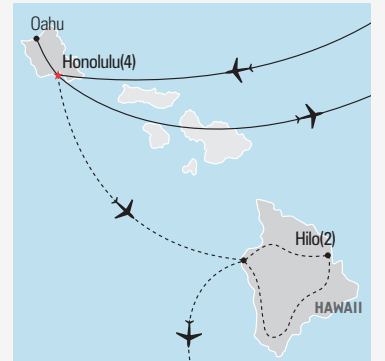


AUGUST

Hawaii officially **became a U.S. state** on **August 21, 1959**. First settled sometime between 124 and 1120 AD, the Hawaiian islands were fairly isolated until the British arrived in 1778. After the Kingdom of Hawaii was established in 1795, American immigration began almost immediately and the U.S. became its primary partner in trade.
