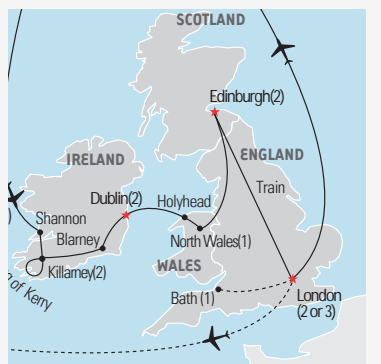

William Shakespeare was born in Stratford-upon-Avon, Warwickshire, England and baptized on **April 26, 1564**. Shakespeare, with his wife Anne Hathaway, also fathered three children: Susanna, Judith and Hamnet.
